

# Sterling Silver Studio's 2019-2020 Performing Arts Company Audition Information

Anyone is welcome to audition for the Performing Arts Company (PAC) teams. These teams consist of dancers and twirlers who work hard and are dedicated to their teams. These teams travel throughout Wisconsin and Minnesota. They usually compete in 4 to 5 local and out of town competitions.

### Auditions

Auditions are based on experience, knowledge and execution of technique, how quickly you learn routines, levels passed, etc. Auditions will be held on Monday, August 5. There will be different auditions for different styles.

There is a \$35 audition fee per person per style. Register now online or at the desk.

### Parent & Meeting—August 5 at 6:00 PM

This is a required meeting for all parents of students that are going to be on 2019-2020 PAC teams. We will be discussing the PAC policies, competitions, expectations, etc.

There will be a sign-in sheet at the meeting for all parents. Please sign in when you arrive, so know which parent attended for each student. All students pre-registered for audition by August 2 will have their listed on our audition sheet.

### Requirements

1. In order for our PAC students to continue to improve and advance as performers we require that all PAC students are enrolled in at least 2 PAC teams during the 2019-2020 season.
2. NEW—To help improve our dancers abilities and to not take away from teachers' PAC choreography classes, all PAC dance & acro team members are required to take a technique & conditioning class during the 2019-2020 season. We see so much potential in our dancers that we want to fully bring that out this year. This will work on technique, body strength & control as well as flexibility.
3. Level testing in Jazz, Twirl & Acro. Students that have level tested will be able to advance to higher teams of those styles. Level testing is to ensure that all students on a team can execute the same skills on the same levels and everyone continues to progress.

### Dance, Twirling & Acro Levels

The level camps are only offered during the summer months. This is the performer's opportunity to advance and learn new skills before starting the new PAC season.

### Level Camps:

- Twirl, Jazz & Ballet—July 29—August 1 (testing August 2)

### Weekly Level Advancement Classes (starts July 25):

- Acro—Tuesdays 6:30-7:15 PM (P, 1, 2) or 7:15-8:15 PM (3+)
- Tap—Wednesdays 4:00-4:45 PM (P, 1, 2)
- Jazz & Ballet—Wednesdays 6:15-7:00 PM
- Twirl—Wednesdays 7:00-8:00 PM

### Level Testing

Testing dates are available on the Friday of that camp week. Students that are registered for the summer level camps will receive an email when level testing sign-up is available. Testing is \$15 per 15-minute time slot (**1 time slot for B, 1, 2 & 3 and 2 time slots for 4 & above**). Know each skill on the level you are testing for. **Bring your level sheet to your testing time.**
