Spring Recital Costume Orders Due Dec. 1

You will be ordering your costumes through the Sterling Silver Studio costume website & by filling out a Google Form. The website & ordering information will be emailed to families by Nov 20 & due by Dec 1.

COSTUMES: Each class will have a different costume. Find your child's costume image, price, tights & shoes by clicking on their class day of the week on the top menu & finding their class time.

ORDERING: There's ordering information on the costume website. All orders will be placed on the Google Form online.

SAMPLE COSTUMES: Trying on sample costumes is the best way to know what size your performer will need. We will have sample costumes available to try on in the Studio Boutique.

MEASUREMENTS: If you would like us to measure your performer, please bring your performer into the Studio Boutique and our office staff will be able to help you.

When ordering your Spring Recital costume, **girth** is the most important measurement (measuring from top of shoulder, around through the legs and back up to the shoulder). Costumes will stretch in the bust, waist and hips, but don't really stretch length ways in the girth.

PERFORMER GROWTH: These costumes will be worn for recital pictures on March 26 & 27 and for Spring Recital on May 7. Order according to your child's growing pattern or if they are due for a growth spurt.

COSTUME CHARGES: Costume charges for each class will be automatically added to your ledger by our Costume Manager, Connie. She will be sending you an email with costume charges, subject: "Transaction Detail" when they are applied to your ledger.

If you DO NOT plan on performing in the Spring Recital on May 7, please contact Connie and she can remove the costume charges and take your child's name off the costume list. Connie@SterlingSilverStudio.com

PAYMENT OPTIONS: You may pay for your costumes with cash, check, credit card, account on file, and fundraiser money. Costumes must be paid in full before they are ordered.

FUNDRAISER MONEY: If you wish to use fundraiser money for your costumes you are able to do so by selecting the Fundraiser Money option on the Google Form when you are ordering your costumes.

Cathedral Families: Scrip Certificates and credits can not be used towards costume orders.

How To Use Your Funds:

2. **For Costumes:** Select the "Use Fundraiser Money" when filling out your Google Form for costume orders
3. **For Merchandise:** When making a purchase you can inform the desk staff you would like to use funds for that purchase.
