Sterling Silver Studio will be holding the 2024-2025 Company 91 (CO91) team auditions on **Monday**, **July 29** with a required parent meeting at 6:00 PM.

Contact your student's instructor to see if he/she is ready to audition for CO91 teams.

Prepare for auditions by attending spring & summer

classes of the styles you plan on auditioning for. Attend summer level classes and testing dates.

Each CO91 student is required to enroll in at least 2 CO91 classes and a technique class for the 2024-2025 season.

We do require level testing for tap, twirl, jazz, ballet and acro CO91 teams.

These styles are currently the fastest growing teams in the studio. This requirement is not to hold anyone back or to keep anyone from auditioning.

This is to build stronger teams by:

 Encouraging students to excel to the next level of their skill and performance ability.

- Ensuring each team member will be able to perform at a similar skill level
- Guaranteeing that everyone knows all of the necessary skills to audition for that style of team.

It is imperative to the success of the program that everyone meets this day to fully understand their role in the rehearsal and the show. On rehearsal & showcase dates, our focus must be on the performers, and all volunteers must be prepared prior to these dates.

At the volunteer meetings, you will receive all of the information on your position to ensure a smooth rehearsal & showcase, as well as your wristband that each volunteer is required to wear backstage. This is an additional measure that we take to help keep the event secure.

Expectations:

Volunteers must be present to fulfill their jobs at the dress rehearsal AND show.

- <u>Senior Rehearsal</u>: Volunteers arrive by 4:00 on Wednesday, April 24 at Wessman Arena. Rehearsal begins at 4:30.
- Junior Rehearsal: Volunteers arrive by 4:00 on Thursday, April 25 at Wessman Arena. Rehearsal begins at 4:30.
- Mini Rehearsal: Volunteers arrive by 4:00 on Friday, April 26 at Wessman Arena. Rehearsal begins at 4:30.

All volunteers need to be in place before students arrive for the showcase.

 Mini Show: April 27—Arrive by 8:30 AM at Wessman Arena. Students arrive by 9:00. Show begins at 10:00.

- Junior Show: April 28—Arrive by 9:30 AM on at Wessman Arena. Students arrive by 10:00. Show begins at 11:00.
- <u>Senior Show</u>: April 28—Arrive by 1:30
 PM on at Wessman Arena. Students arrive by 2:00. Show begins at 3:00
